Weldon Village Hall Report

Defibrillator

I got the impression that they is some confusion on who maintains the Defibrillator, how many times it is serviced and who are the first responders. I will be looking into this so the correct information can be circulated.

New doors and Windows

Work to replace these w/c 25th - 29th October 2021, Hall will be closed, no bookings will take place during these dates.

Roof Issue

A survey was carried out regarding the issues to the hall roof, full report not yet issued. A number of dents on the side of the roof above the Pre-school shed where noticed where it's been used to climb upon to access the roof by youths possibly to retrieve balls and other items of play within the village hall boundary.

CCTV

Neighbouring houses have reported that there is some misuse of the car park area and park area to antisocial behaviour with youths being out after dark messing around and making a nuisance of themselves. It was mentioned that CCTV had been trailed in the past and wasn't successful due to a resident complaint of invasion of privacy to neighbouring homes but it was brought up again to whether CCTV would help in the future.

I have been informed of the past CCTV matters and these have now been addressed and hopefully resolved. It was advised that the Neighbouring Policing Team to be contacted in the future of any problems.

Pre-School

Pre-School have asked for permission to install a water play facility in the back yard of the Village Hall. Further info is needed regarding size, maintenance, cleaning etc before any agreement can take place.

Floor Sealing

This is usually done by now but looks like it will take place after Christmas 2021.

COVID-19

Extra cleaning is still taking place. It was decided to add 'best practice' guidance to the halls hire agreement/conditions (including hand sanitiser, bring your own cleaning equipment etc). Future bookings to complete and submit new risk assessment form.
