PMC.272	Apologies had been received from Cllrs Priem and Vickers both were approved.
PMC.272	There were no declarations of interest
PMC.274	Presentation from Gary Chisholm - Mr Chilsom had not responded to Cllr
	Shepard's email asking him to attend this meeting.
PMC.275	The minutes from the meeting held on 25th July were approved after the date of the
	meeting was changed
PMC.276	Land Registry – Cllr Shepard has enough evidence that the Parish Council has been tending the Triangle for many years and is collating the evidence to submit a report
	to the full Parish Council in preparation to apply to the Land Registry for adverse
	possession,
PMC.277	Weldon in Bloom - The Daffodil Bulbs have now arrived and it is hoped to start
	planting in the next week or so. Areas selected are Kettering Road junction with
	Church Street, Deene End/East Crescent in the area by the current planters, Oundle
	Road, The Green, Woodlands, Church Street junction with Oundle Road, Hillside
	Crescent junction with Corby Road by the Post Box, Gretton Road Corner and Church Walk junction with Oundle Road.
	The Clerk agreed to ask the Finance Committee for permission to purchase 1Kg of
	Wildflower seeds at a cost of £149, this would cover an area of 330sq metres and to
	purchase 2 established Wisteria to be planted at the railings of the Green on
	Stamford Road.
PMC.278	Hills & Hollows - Cllr Shepard explained that he has several updated quotes for the
	bridge. MR Industrial Services £35k plus VAT this has no drawings, Beaver Bridges £34K plus VAT with an additional £2K for drawings. PGR £75K plus VAT and Colston
	Bridges £10K plus VAT this has no pad stones or drawings. Cllr Shepard
	recommends Colston Bridges and then Beaver Bridges. Hopefully BAM will be able
	to supply the specific drawings and padstones. The Clerk will put the
	recommendations to the Finance Committee for approval at the next full council

PMC.279	Benches – The Wicksteed Park Bench is ready to be sited, the Clerk has purchased a plaque in the memory of her mother, it was agreed that it should be placed on the
	Village Green. The other bench when ready will be placed on Rose Avenue
PMC.280	The Leys and Pocket Park – the bollards have now been installed at the entrances
	to the Leys. The Clerk highlighted that the one for the Green can not be installed
	until access has been agreed for the contractor grass cutters.
PMC.281	The Gandy Field – BAM have agreed to clear the site and provide the main path.
PMC.282	with the QPJ planting to start during the autumn. Report from Tree Warden – the trees from 52 Corby Road upwards need lower

	Church Walk has still to be repaired. The footpath width along Oundle Road should
	be completed by the end of September, it is unknown if the Kettering Road footpath
	width will be done at the same time.
