Draft Minutes of Working Party Meeting held on Monday 23rd January 2023

WP.084 Apologies had been received from Cllrs A. Page and G Stray both were accepted

WP.085 A resident raised concerns about the amount of HGVs using Church Street. It was suggested that perhaps the proposed crossing on Church Street from Glebe Farm could be a raised table this may slow traffic down. Cllr Dowsett agreed to move the footpath from a priority 2 to priority 1 on the Action Log. Jo France agreed to look into the possibility of using shared services for the footpath and road, this is not a common practise. Jo will also look into the possibility of making Church Street one way.

Review of a meeting held on 11th January which Simon Taylor, on behalf of Weldon Parish Council, attended along with 2 Persimmon personnel. it was agreed to split the traffic calming into needs and wants depending on location. Needs - will be delivered by Persimmon in the phase of work.

Want - to be looked at a later stage.

Corby Road - Want -Due to the current traffic claiming in place, other parts of the village have a higher priority.

High Street - Need - Traffic calming needed to reduce traffic and speed, possibly 2 raised tables.

Kettering Road - Need - Traffic calming needed to reduce traffic and speed, 30 MPH sign to be moved to A43/Magna Park Roundabout, traffic calming to start around the location of Church Street with possible speed humps.

Oundle Road - Need - Traffic calming needed to reduce traffic and speed, traffic calming to start around the location of Church Street possible speed humps to the Persimmon Roundabout.

Stamford Road - Want - Due to the current traffic calming in place, other parts of the village have a higher priority.

Persimmon has a budget and will work on a solution for High Street, Kettering Road and Oundle Road to deliver as much traffic calming as possible for the village within that budget. The proposal should be ready to be approved at the March Full Council Meeting.

Spine Road Completion is being held up by NNC, who have changed the design goal posts previously set by them, Persimmon and NNC are working on a solution.
